

Crochet Cup Component for Pathways Project

Single crochet – J hook or larger

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Fold back end of Plarn to make a loop and chain 3 and join the circle by inserting the hook into the first loop, yarn over and pull through. This is a slip stitch.

Now single crochet (thru, yo, back, yo back through two loops on hook) into each of those 4 stitches. Slip stitch to join the circle and chain 1.

For this round single crochet (1) into the first stitch, (2) into the next stitch single crochet , then alternate 1,2 to complete the round (6 stitches).

Join with slip stitch, Chain 1

Next round the pattern is 1 Single crochet,1Single crochet, 2 Single crochet, 1, 1, 2 to complete the round. Slip stitch to join, chain 1.

Next round single crochet 1,1,1, 2, 1,1,1, 2, to complete the round. Slip stitch to join, chain 1.
Continue to add 1 more stitch to the increasing pattern each round until you have reached the desired size.

When desired size is reached (I like a variety of sizes, but generally a hat size) continue to single crochet into each stitch until desired depth is reached (approximately as tall as it is wide).



Cup components will be used in a small or large size.

Small cups are approximately 6 inches circumference and 2-3 inches deep. Slight variety in sizes welcome. They should be made in green. 3-5 bags

Large cups will be the size of a small hat – appx 16 inch circumference and 8 inches deep. They should be made in New York Times blue. Slight variations in size are desired. Approximately 20-25 bags.
